


Webinservice Login & eLearning

To access Webinservice, go to the Kershaw County Medical Center Intranet and click the Webinservice button or enter the following address into your internet browser:

The login page as shown below will display (within a few seconds). Enter your first name and last name, as documented on your Human Resource record (ex. paycheck), and enter your date of birth with slashes (/) between the month and day, day and year.

General Instructions for Taking Tests

You have chosen to begin the test on:

Kershaw County Medical Center: Bloodborne Pathogens

There are 4 questions in this test. Be sure you have enough time to complete it before you continue. Once you begin, if you exit before completing the exam, all unanswered questions will be scored as incorrect.

Some tests require additional materials, such as calculators or coding manuals, so ensure that you have these available if they are appropriate for the lessons you are working in. You will know if these additional materials are required for a test if they were required to complete the lesson.

Tests are comprised of True/False, Multiple Choice, and Fill-in-the-blank questions. Tests are scored based upon the number of questions you answer correctly from all of those in the test.

Some fill-in-the-blank questions may require multiple answers. This is common with the ICD-9-CM or HCPCS/CPT Coding lessons that require you to code an actual case study. When you must enter more than one answer, separate your answers with **EITHER** a space **OR** a comma. You cannot use both of these methods in a single question. It is best to get in the habit of using either spaces OR commas to separate your answers. Mixing the separators you use will result in questions being scored incorrectly.

If you are ready to begin, click **Take Test** in the menu above.

If you have the option to take this test later and would rather take this test later, click **Personal Page** in the menu above to return to your home page.


Click the Take Test button again to view the test. Answer all of the questions and click the Submit Test button at the bottom of the test. The following result page will display.
